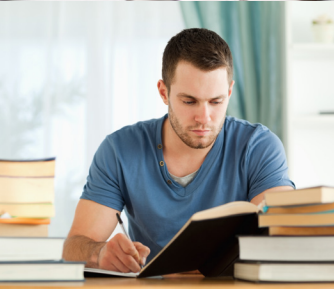

The Level 3 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools is a qualification from NCFE. The purpose of this qualification is to confirm your competence in a Level 3 Teaching Assistant role or similar, that supports learning in a school environment. This qualification enables you to develop and demonstrate the skills and knowledge to work in an unsupervised role at times or in a team leading position within the school workforce, directly supporting the teaching and learning of pupils in primary, secondary or special schools. You could also use this qualification to support your progression to further learning within the teaching and learning and education sector.

To obtain the NCFE Level 3 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools qualification you must complete 11 mandatory units:

- Understand child and young person development
- Understand how to safeguard the wellbeing of children and young people
- Support children and young people's health and safety
- Engage in personal development in health, social care or children and young people's settings
- Support learning activities
- Promote children and young people's positive behaviour
- Develop professional relationships with children, young people and adults
- Promote equality, diversity and inclusion in work with children and young people
- Support assessment for learning
- Communication and professional relationships with children, young people and adults
- Schools as organisations

How do I study and how long will it take?

This is a blended learning programme with 180 Guided Learning Hours, which should normally take around six months to complete. The subject knowledge is delivered online through the Teaching Zone on the iQualify UK website.

Studying online is extremely flexible, as you can study at the time and place that best suits you, without the cost and hassle of getting to classes. Everything you need is provided online in the Teaching Zone, so you won't ever miss anything, and you can repeat sections until you fully understand them. You also have a personal online tutor, who is a subject expert who will support you in your studies, and who you can contact if you have any questions. All you need is Internet access through a phone, tablet, laptop or PC! The time it takes in practice is up to you, and will vary depending on your commitment and how easy you find it to study.

iQualify UK will work with your school to negotiate a partnership and develop your bespoke learning pathway. A team in the UK will conduct quarterly seminars, workshops and knowledge based lectures at key selected locations.

For the assessment you are required to create a portfolio of evidence which demonstrates achievement of 100% of the learning outcomes and assessment criteria associated with each unit. The main pieces of evidence for the portfolio could include:

- assessor observation – completed observational checklists and related action plans
- witness testimony
- candidate's proof of work
- worksheets assignments/projects/reports
- record of professional discussion
- record of oral and written questioning
- candidate and peer reports
- Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

There will be a minimum of three observations totalling a minimum of three hours for each student and there is a requirement for a minimum of 30 hours of practice for this qualification.

Entry requirements

This qualification is for those members of the school workforce who directly support the teaching and learning of pupils. This is a competence based qualification so there is a requirement for assessment in a real work environment. You must have a placement (either as a volunteer or as a member of staff) in a school environment. It is not a strict requirement, but it is recommended that the placement should be for the duration of the qualification. There aren't any specific recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification.
